NOTES:

- All stats are based on Standard Scoring of 3 points for field goals and 1 point for extra points
(except for the Bonus Total column which increases 40-49 yard FG's to 4 points, and FG's of 50 yards and over to 5 points)
- "Attempted" = maximum number of kicking points the team could have had if they made every kick
- The Kdefensive "factors" are the median by which teams allow kicking points, as compared to their opponents average scoring
(i.e. smaller numbers under 1.0 equal better kicking defense, larger numbers over 1.0 = not so good)
- Misses key: SH = short, WR = wide right, WL = wide left, CR = cross bar, RU = right upright, LU = left upright, B = blocked, T = tipped
